

## Spiritual Hunger

Psalm 42:1-3 – As the deer pants for streams of water, so pants my soul after you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God; when shall I come and appear before God. My tears have been my meat day and night, while they continually say to me, where is your God?

Psalm 63:1-3, 7-8 – O God, you are my God, early and earnestly with I seek you: my soul thirsts for you, my flesh longs for you in a dry and thirsty land where there is no water; to see your power and your glory, so as I have seen you in the sanctuary. You have been my help, therefore in the shadow of your wings will I rejoice. My soul follows hard after you; your right hand upholds me.

Isaiah 41:17-18 – The poor and needy seek water and there is none and their tongue fails for thirst. I, the lord will answer them, I the God of Israel, will not forsake them. I will open rivers on the bare heights and fountains in the midst of the valleys; I will make the wilderness a pool of water and the dry land springs of water.

Psalm 143:6 – I spread forth my hands unto you; my soul thirsts after you, as a weary land. Make haste to answer me, O Lord; my spirit fails: hide not your face from me...

Isaiah 26:9 – With my soul have I desired you in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek you earnestly...

Isaiah 55:1-3, 6-8 – Ho, every one that thirsts, come to the waters and he that has no money; come buy and eat; yea, come buy wine and milk without money and without price. Wherefore do you spend money for that which is not bread and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Hearken diligently unto me and eat that which is good and let your soul delight itself in fatness. Incline your ear and come to me; hear and your soul shall live... Seek the Lord while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near; let the wicked

forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts and let him return unto the Lord and He will have mercy upon Him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.

Jeremiah 2:13 – For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns that can hold no water.

John 6:27-28, 35 – Work not for the food which perishes, but for the food which abides unto eternal life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for Him the Father, even God, hath sealed. They said therefore unto him, What must we do, that we may work the works of God? Jesus answered and said unto them, this is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent... Jesus said to them, I am the bread of life; he that comes to me shall not hunger and he that believes on me shall never thirst.

1 Peter 2:2-3– As newborn babes long for the sincere spiritual milk of the Word, that you may grow thereby; if you have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

### Water of life:

Revelations 22:17 – And the Spirit and the bride say, come. And he that hears let him say, come. And he that is thirsty, let him come: he that will, let him take the water of life freely.

John 7:37-38 – If any man thirst, let him come to me and drink. He that believes on me as the scripture has said, for within him shall flow rivers of living water. But this He spoke of the Spirit which they that believed on Him should receive...

John 4:14 – Whosoever drinks of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall become in him a well of water springing up unto eternal life.

### God Fills:

Matthew 5:6 – Blessed are they that hunger and thirst after righteousness; for they shall be filled.

Psalms 107:4-9 – They wandered in the wilderness in a desert way; they found no city of habitation. Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. Then they cried unto Jehovah in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses, He led them also by a straight way, that they might go to a city of habitation. Oh that men would praise the Lord for his lovingkindness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul He fills with good.

Psalms 36:7-9 – How precious is your mercy, O God! And the children of men take refuge under the shadow of your wings. They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of your house; and you will make them drink of the river of your pleasures. For with you is the fountain of life: in you light shall we see light.

### Come to Him:

John 5:39-40 – You search the scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and there are they which bear witness of me; and you will not come to me, that you may have life.

Matthew 11:28-30 – Come to me all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn of me, for I am meek and lowly in heart and you shall find rest for your soul. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

John 7:37-39 – If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink...

### Don't let your fire go out:

Exodus 24:17-18 - And the sight of the glory of the Lord was like a devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel. And Moses went into the midst of the cloud...

Hebrews 12:29 – For our God is a consuming fire.

2 Chronicles 7:1 - Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the Lord filled the house.

Psalms 68:2 – As smoke is driven away, so drive them away: as wax melts before the fire, so let the wicked perish at the presence of God.

Proverbs 26:20 – Where no wood is, there the fire goes out.

Romans 12:11 – in diligence; fervent in spirit, serving the Lord.

Leviticus 6:12-13 – And the fire upon the altar shall be kept burning thereon, it shall not go out; and the priest shall burn wood on it every morning: and he shall lay the burnt-offering in order upon it, and shall burn thereon the fat of the peace-offerings. Fire shall be kept burning upon the altar continually; it shall not go out.

2 Timothy 1:6 – Fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you when I laid my hands on you. Stir it up.

Acts 2:3-4 - And there appeared to them cloven tongues like as of fire and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost...

Isaiah 64:7 – Stir up yourself.
